BIOGRAPHY

MAISON VON BROCkDORFF was founded by Katharina when she decided to follow her passion while continuing the legacy of her family name. The high-end design brand awakens the desire for unique and precious pieces.

Von Brockdorff is, in fact, the surname of her German-born maternal grandmother, Hildegard Emmi Marie Estebana, whose own grandmother was from Spain.

The genealogy of the von Brockdorff family members has been traced back to the 13th century. Since the grandmother married and her only brother had no descendants, this branch of the von Brockdorff family saw the end of the family name.

Katharina decided to bring the name back to life as an everlasting legacy by creating this brand Franco-German with a dash of Spanish influence, encompassing these two cultures - perhaps all three - and carrying on each of their traditions and noblessen.

With more than two decades of experience as an architectural project manager, then as an interior designer and designer, Katharina has acquired a wealth of expertise and skills.

During these years she conceived, designed, managed and completed prestigious projects within world renowned agencies such as Jean Nouvel, Zaha Hadid and Paul Andreu, to name a few. Katharina earned their trust, from Hamburg to London, from China to New York and from Monaco to Paris.

Whether she designs an opera or a table, the intention is always the same: pure, flowing, elegant and timeless lines.

Her work (furniture, lighting, rugs, objects and accessories), distinguished by its quality, elegance and beauty, would not feel out of place in the greatest French design studios.

Made in France, these creations rely on the expertise of the craftsmen to make each piece unique.

Each collection is full of emotion; each creation carries a story, often inspired by a childhood memory, or imbued with a London diversity and a Parisian elegance reminiscent of her studies or the sweep of her travels. Katharina's eyes are always open to discovery.

She collects jewels of wonder, then lets them shine in a beautiful light in her work. She shows fragments of life and tributes to her family, to craftsmanship and to multiculturalism.

Each piece is designed with an eye to materials that are preferably combined, pure, rich, vibrant and noble. Think brass, bronze, alabaster, precious stones, rare wood essences, silk and velvet.

She takes care of a dialog between these materials and all their variations to reveal and transcend their elegance.

Katharina breathes soul into each of her creations, giving a true presence and existence to the places she so obviously sublimates.
